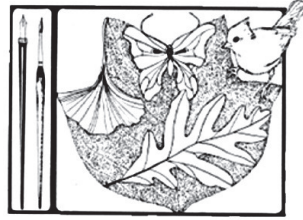

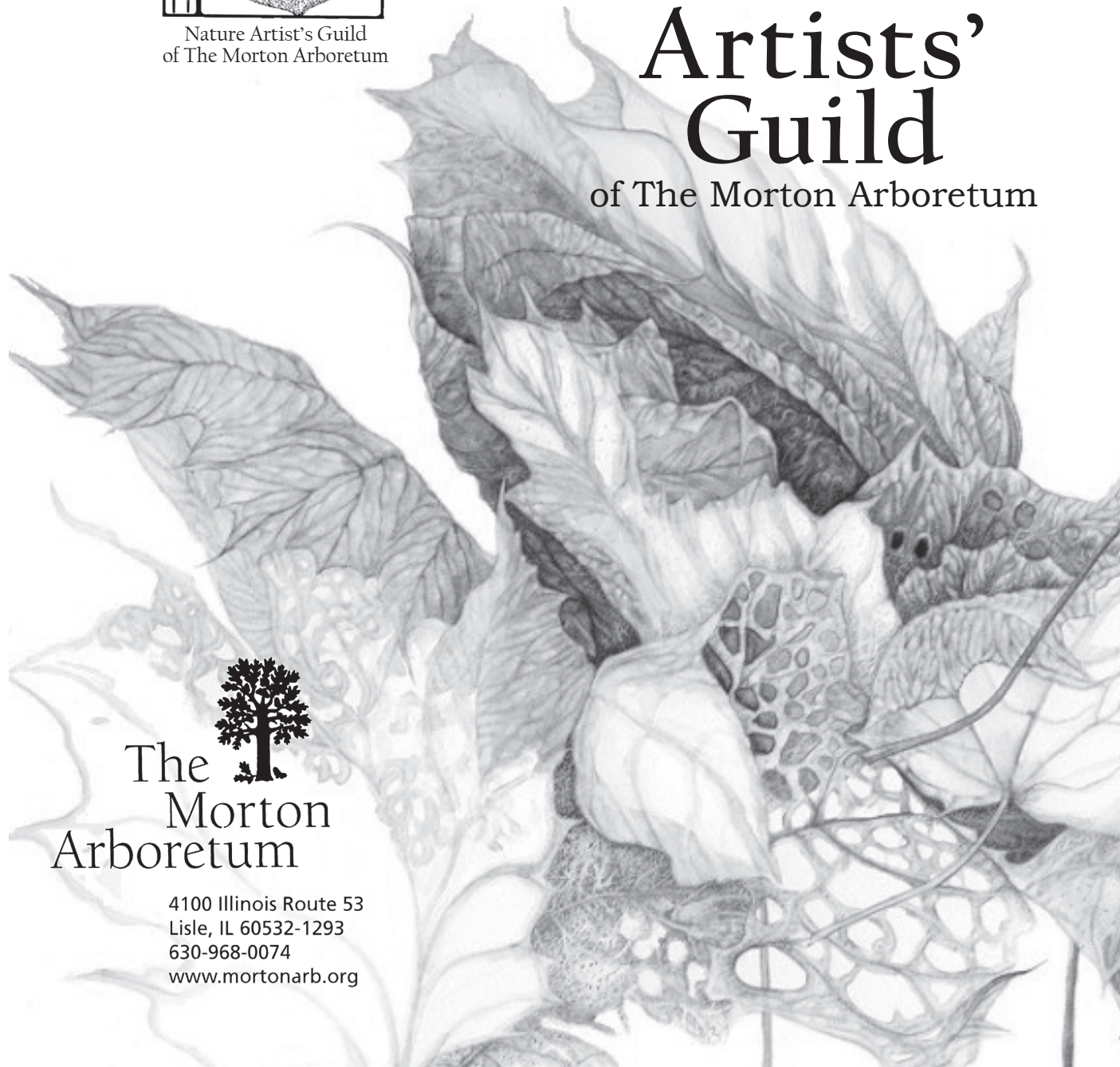

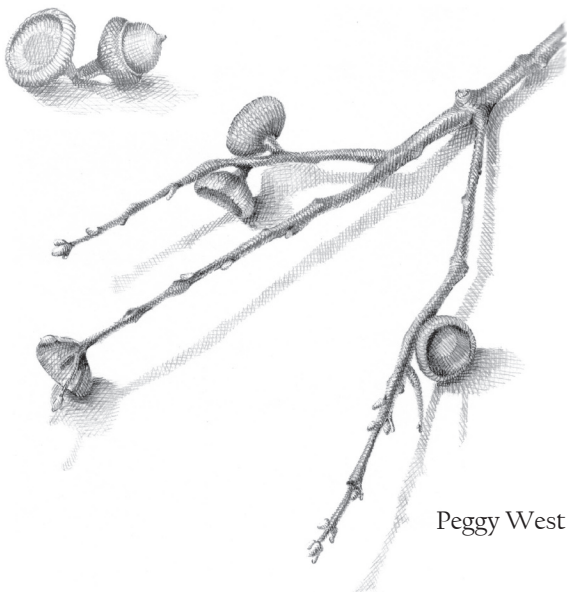
## Interested in Art, Plants, Natural History?

The Nature Artists' Guild of The Morton Arboretum is a Special Interest Group of the Arboretum. It was officially formed in 1986 as a not-for-profit organization developed to gather together people of like interests in exploring and sharing the field of natural history art.

## Guild Benefits

### Meetings

Six Formal Meetings are held on the first Thursdays of February, April, June, August, October, and December, from 7 to 9 pm at the Arboretum. The first five meetings of the year feature an exceptional program and a short business meeting. The December social meeting includes installation of officers, a raffle, and culinary treats. Guests are welcome at all activities.



## Workshops and Paint-outs

These are informal special interest meetings that provide networking opportunities, continued stimulation, and enrichment,

- At **Workshops**, participants “work” on special projects or learn new skills. Two of the workshops each year are scheduled to create items for the Ways and Means shop at the Guild exhibitions.
- At **Paint-outs**, members paint together in exciting locations.

## Publications

- The *Yearbook* contains the Guild bylaws, exhibition guidelines, and the membership listing.
- Four issues of the *Quarterly* the illustrated newsletter, contains a short updated calendar, special articles, reports on Guild and members' activities, notice of upcoming classes, and outside events of interest.
- The interim *Bulletin* lists meetings, events, reminders, and updates.

## Exhibitions

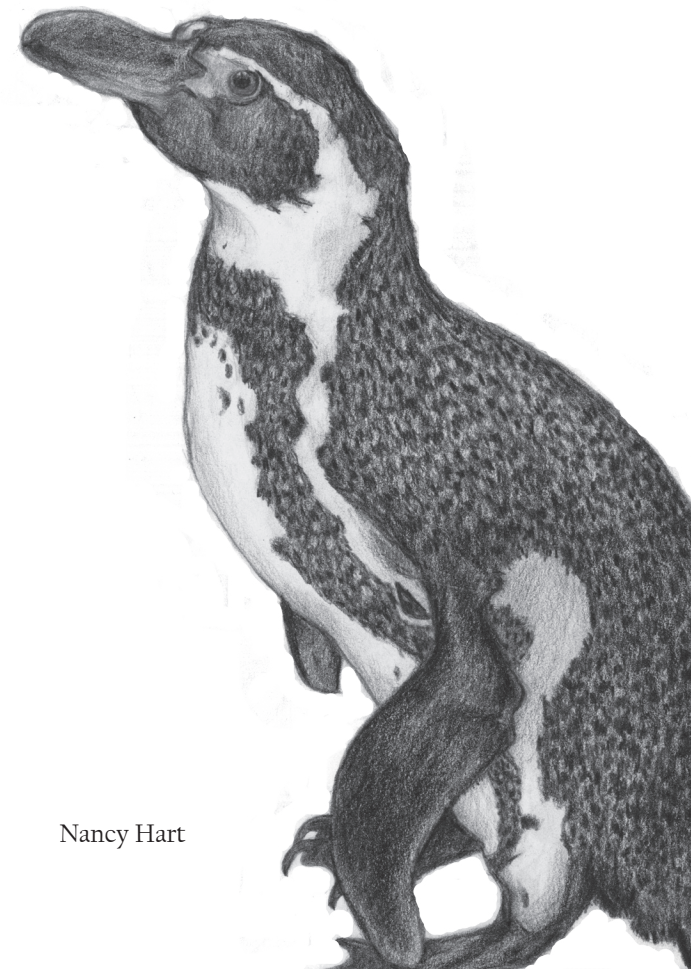
A Spring and a Fall Holiday Exhibit at the Arboretum showcase the art of Guild members at all levels of achievement. The exhibits are: noncompetitive and refereed only for scientific content. Additional, smaller exhibits are usually held outside the Arboretum. Sale of art is permitted only after the shows, on an individual basis.

## Membership

Membership in the Guild is open to all who are interested in natural history art. It is separate from membership in The Morton Arboretum.
